### **Travel by train: We strongly recommend to arrive via train!**

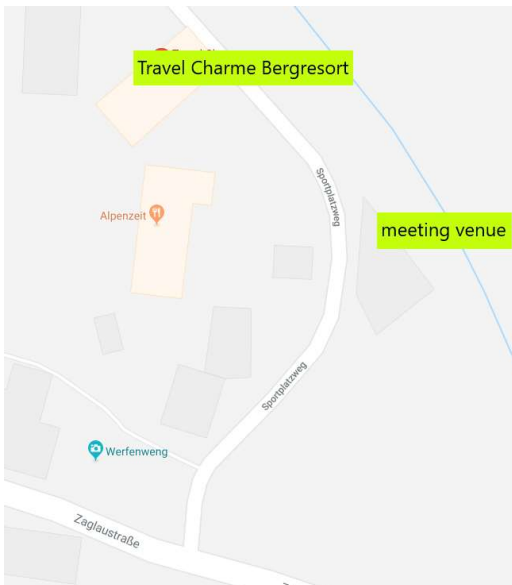
Coming from Salzburg / München:
